WHAT: Student-run campus club *The World is Just a Book Away USC*, is holding its 2^{nd} annual 5K race on Sunday, March 25, 2012 on the USC campus with a goal of registering 500 participants and raising \$20,000 to build their second library for non-profit *The World is Just a Book Away (WIJABA)*.
